Fact Sheet Seven: Staging Events in Glenorchy

One of the ways Glenorchy Council is supporting cultural events, is by the maintenance and development of suitable venues.

Glenorchy's many parks, halls and public spaces provide a variety of opportunities for the staging of events - big and small. Would your event, for example, work well at the Pool? Glenorchy Memorial Pool is available for hire. It may be an ideal venue for a summer event such as an outdoor film screening or small music concert. You may have a favourite local park or street suitable for a neighbourhood picnic or street party. Ask around. There may be interesting spaces you haven't considered or been aware of!

Seasonal weather should always be a consideration when choosing an event venue. If you decide to stay indoors, Council has detailed information on public halls. To get exact details on size, seating, catering facilities etc., freecall the Infoline on 1800 635 488 for a brochure.

Outdoor events in Glenorchy are a definite feature of the warmer months. Below is a list of *some* of the possible event venues in Glenorchy. Other outdoor venues to consider include KGV, Claremont Recreation Ground, and Giblins Reserve. All venues listed below have suitable resources for *parking, water and power*.

Venue: Council Front Lawns

Capacity: 1500

Power: Multiple AC outlets.

Cover over staging: No, organizers need to provide staging

Disability Access: Excellent

No of Toilets: 6 and 1 accessible (Bus Interchange)

Parking Spaces (weekend): 50 to 100 spaces available rear of Council

Additional Features: Covered kiosk available, serviced by Glenorchy Bus Interchange

Venue: Talosa Park Soundshell

Capacity: 15 000

Power: Three phase and multiple AC outlets

Cover over staging: Yes

Disability Access: Moderate

No of Toilets: 6 to 8 cubicles on site, port a loos needed for major events

Parking Spaces (weekend): 100 to 200. Major Event parking plan available from Council

Additional Features: BBQ huts for hire on site

Venue: Montrose Community Foreshore Park

Capacity: 10 000 plus

Power: Three Phase and AC Outlets

Cover over staging: Rotunda to be completed for 2005

Disability Access: Moderate

No of Toilets: 2F 2M

Parking Spaces: Event parking plan available from GCC

Additional Features: Boat access to the Derwent

Venue: Benjafield Park

Capacity: Up to 60000

Power: Three phase power available

Cover over staging: No, organizers need to provide staging

Disability Access: Moderate
No of Toilets: 3 Unisex cubicles
Parking Spaces (Sunday): Up to 200 places behind Hopkins Street
Additional Features: Close to the Moonah shopping precinct, and public transport

Venue: Collinsvale New Rec Ground
Capacity: Up to 5000
Power: Three Phase Power/ AC outlets
Cover over staging: No permanent staging
Disability Access: Limited
No of Toilets: 8 permanent cubicles available
Parking Spaces: 50 to 100. Any major event requires a traffic and parking plan
Additional Features: Outstanding rural and natural setting.
