

Driver to Collect Bin Service

Service Description

Glenorchy City Council undertakes to collect garbage from residential and some commercial properties, where each tenement shall receive an authorised receptacle to store and dispose the garbage.

This service is available for residents unable to place their wheelie bin at the kerbside due to age, illness or a physical disability. A Doctor's Certificate is required by Council to access this service. For further information please call the Environmental Health Office on 6216 6797.

How to use your service

Wheelie bins need to be accessible for the drivers to service the property. For further information please call 6216 6797.

There are no extra costs associated with driver to collect. Normal waste management charges apply.
