Eligibility For Discounted Fees

All fees must be paid within a prescribed time period. In case of a dog more than 6 months of age at the beginning of the financial year, on or before the 31st day of July in that year. In the case of a dog passing the age of 6 months during a financial year on or before the 30th day of the month in which the dog passes that age.

PENSIONERS - The discounted fee for pensioners is for one dog only and on production of a Commonwealth Pension Concession Card. Any other dog kept by a pensioner is at the applicable rate.

DESEXED - Owners must produce a veterinarian certificate at the time of initial registration.

SPECIAL ASSISTANCE - Sight, hearing and special needs trained dogs.

Payment can be made in person at Council Offices, or through the post. This form must accompany payment.

NOTE: The owner of a dog that is aged over 6 months that is unregistered is guilty of an offence and is liable to an on the spot fine of \$120.00 or on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$500.00.
