Eligibility for Discounted Fees

Payments for all registration categories, must be received by 31st July in the applicable year of registration, to be eligible for the discounted fee.

Pensioners - The discounted fee for pensioners is for one dog only on production of a Commonwealth Pension Concession Card. Any other dog kept by the pensioner is at the applicable rate.

De-Sexed Dogs - Owners who wish to claim a deduction on dog registration for spayed or neutered dogs for the first time, must produce a veterinarian certificate at the Council Offices prior to registration.

Breeding - Owners must produce a current stud prefix card issued by the Tasmanian Canine Association.

Greyhounds - Owners must produce a current registration certificate issued by Racing Services Tasmania.

Working Dogs - Owners must satisfy Council that the dog is a bona fide working dog pursuant to the Dog Control Act 2000.

Special Assistance - Sight, hearing and special needs trained dogs.

New Registration - The owner of a dog that is over the age of 6 months must register the dog. A person must not conceal, or dispose of a dog to evade registration of the dog. The owner of a dog that is unregistered is guilty of an offence and is liable for a \$120 on the spot fine or upon summary conviction a fine not exceeding \$500.

IN THE EVENT YOU REQUIRE ANY CHANGES TO BE MADE, THEY MUST BE DONE AT THE COUNCIL OFFICES OR IN WRITING PRIOR TO PAYMENT BEING MADE. IT IS AN OFFENCE UNDER THE DOG CONTROL ACT 2000 TO GIVE MISLEADING OR FALSE INFORMATION.

NOTE

- Pension cards must be presented at time of payment.
- Receipts must be kept as proof of payment.
- Discounted fees only apply to payments made prior to 31 July.
