



In 2005 Glenorchy City Council introduced "Lifetime Tags" when owners registered their dogs.

This is not a lifetime registration, owners are still required to renew their dogs registrations each year.

Remember it is a "Lifetime Tag" meaning the tag you got last year is for the life of the dog. **Just like your car registration.**

**Q: What if my dog loses or destroys it's lifetime tag?**

A: You would do the same as is currently required - report the tag as lost or destroyed to Council and purchase a replacement tag.

**Q: What is the benefit of a lifetime tag?**

A: Money saved on not buying bulk tags each year can be utilised in other areas such as waste plastic affecting our environment.

**Q: Why did Council make this decision?**

A: Only a few tags are lost or destroyed each year it seems a waste to provide new tags if they are not needed.

**Q: How will I prove my dog is registered each year or, how will my council know if it is not?**

A: Council maintains a Register where all dog registrations are recorded.

**You must also keep your receipt as proof that you have renewed your dogs annual registration.**
