Hobart Milk Factory Pty Ltd is a GCC, TDIA and EPA permitted milk processing facility located at 54 - 56 Gormanston Road in the suburb of Moonah. It currently operates under the conditions set forth in Planning Permit PLN-22-034.

Hobart Milk Factory Pty Ltd.'s Proposed Use / Development for this Planning Application is that of;

- Extending the currently permitted days and times of milk processing facility operation;
- Extending the currently permitted days and times deliveries of raw milk can be made; &
- Allowing the raw milk delivery vehicle to attend and exit site via Gormanston Road entrance.
- ➤ All other conditions found within PLN-22-034 are to remain unaltered.

Hobart Milk Factory Pty Ltd will not be increasing its manufacturing output or input.

The chief concern of this Planning Application is that of ensuring stability to handle seasonal farming changes to scheduled raw milk deliveries and the replacement of production days in lieu of public holidays, factory breakdowns and vehicle breakdowns.

Addressing Glenorchy City Council objectives; 18.0 Light Industrial Zone; 18.3.1 All uses A1. Hours of Operation

The proposed days and times of operation of milk processing facility are as follows;

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday	7:00am to 6:00pm
Public Holidays	8:00am to 5:00pm

There will be a **maximum of 4 milk processes** made per week. Maximum of 8,000 litres per process, per PLN-22-034; Permit Part B; Permit Conditions – Environmental No. 11106. *No increase to current output*.

The proposed days and times of operation fall within the 'Acceptable Solutions' required by The Tasmanian Planning Scheme.

A2. External Lighting

No additional external lights will be required during the operation of milk processing facility or raw milk delivery. Current security lighting is positioned so that direct light does not extend into the adjoining properties.

Falls within the 'Acceptable Solutions' required by The Tasmanian Planning Scheme.

A3. Commercial Vehicle Movements

The proposed days and times raw milk will be delivered to 54 - 56 Gormanston Road.

There will be a maximum of 4 deliveries made per week. No increase to current weekly input.

Delivery to be made via access to site from Gormanston Road entrance.

Site provides sufficient space in car park to turn/manoeuvre vehicle and no reversing is required. Commercial vehicle movements only to be in a forward direction to aid in preventing any unreasonable loss of amenity. Sunderland Street access to site to remain intact, per PLN-22-034.

The proposed days and times and therefore, access and exit via Gormanston Road entrance fall within the 'Acceptable Solutions' required by The Tasmanian Planning Scheme.

- B'Double 59t rated 'not HML' (Higher Mass Limits).
- Vehicle type is permitted to access Gormanston Road.
- Sweep Path for B'Double provided.
