

Notification to Neighbour of a Barking Dog

Dear Neighbour,

I don't know if you are aware, but I would like to let you know that your dog is barking a lot and is disrupting the peace of other residents in the area.

I am getting in touch with you now to let you know, and hope that you may be able to do something about it. I wanted to get in touch with you first rather than me speaking to the Council straight up.

To give you an idea about the barking patterns; generally, your dog barks at these times:

Date	Barking start time	Barking stop time	What is the dog barking at?

I don't want to cause any trouble by bringing this to your attention but felt that it was fair to let you know first. I hope that you can work with your dog to stop the persistent barking.
