Farm Animal Permit Application

😭 Things You Should Know

Before keeping farm animals, please read the following key requirements in this Application. These will help ensure responsible ownership and are enforceable under Glenorchy City Council's Animal Management By-law and Local Government Act 1993.

Animal Control Responsibilities

Animal owners **must ensure** their animals do **not**:

- Enter or stay on private property without permission.
- Enter or stay on public land unless a sign allows that type of animal.
- Attack another animal or person.
- Cause excessive or ongoing noise that unreasonably disturbs neighbours.

Property and Cleanliness Requirements

Owners must ensure:

- Fencing is secure and well-maintained to contain animals.
- Animal housing and areas animals access are kept clean and sanitary.
- Waste and food storage areas are regularly maintained.
- Animal housing must not be within 1 metre of property boundaries or roads.
- Ensure compliance with the Tasmanian Planning Scheme (Glenorchy).

Animal waste must **not** be allowed to:

- Enter neighbouring properties.
- Run off into drains or watercourses.

Keeping Farm Animals in Residential Areas

You must not keep farm animals (except poultry) on residential land without a Council permit.

You may keep poultry without a permit on condition that:

- No roosters are kept.
- The number of birds does not exceed:
 - o 6 on lots between 400 1000m²
 - 12 on lots over 1000m²

To apply for a farm animal permit:

- 1. Complete the **Application Farm Animal Permit**.
- 2. Submit the completed **Application Farm Animal Permit** to Glenorchy City Council. You can lodge this application by:
- In-person lodgement: Visit Glenorchy City Council's Customer Service Centre at 374 Main Road, Glenorchy, between 8:30 am and 5:00 pm, or
- **Email lodgement**: Email the application to gccmail@gcc.tas.gov.au.
- 3. A Council Officer will contact you to advise you of the outcome of your Application, ask further questions, or arrange a property inspection.
