

DRAFT TO FINAL: KEY CHANGES







- In general most comments around the bowl were that it was a good design however this had to be reduced to incorporate more plaza style obstacles
- Many comments were not in favour of the bowl 'fly out' mogul and that this should be removed.
- Overall comments suggested that the facility street run should not have transition as it is trying to incorporate too much and seperates the park.
- Most comments suggested that the region is missing plaza / street style parks and that this is needed within the area. A flowing street park was the majority
- It was suggested that the kink rail blocks flow and should be removed.
- Many people did not like the wallie rock.

- Many people were not in favour of the whippy spine to slappy kerb and mentioned that there are already features like this in the area.
- People suggested that transition features such as quarter pipes should be removed and replaced with street obstacles.
- People liked the Brick China Bank feature with manny pad.
- It was suggested that more street features be incorporated such as rails, hubbas, ledges and hips.
- People mentioned the need for a basic mini ramp, however this can be achieved within the bowl.
- Some people asked for a box jump, however overall the majority of people were asking for street style obstacles and it is difficult to achieve both in a small facility. (also box jumps do not work well in street style skateparks and there is one 15 minutes up the road at EC skatepark).
