Nature Strip Policy

Have you ever thought about maintaining and enhancing your nature strip by planting some shrubs or flowers? Council wants to make it easier for residents to do just this! We are seeking your feedback on the Draft Nature Strip Policy and Guidelines.

Footpath Trading Policy

Footpath trading including portable signs (ie A-Frame signs), display of goods and outside dining can add to an area by creating vibrant and dynamic street frontages for the community to enjoy while enhancing and promoting businesses. We are seeking your feedback on the Footpath Trading Policy and Guidelines prior to it going to Council for their consideration.

Food Van Policy

Are you interested in operating a mobile food business (food van) on Council property?

Are you a resident or visitor who would like to access food vans on Council property?

Or are you concerned about the impacts of food vans operating on Council property?

Glenorchy City Council is proposing a Policy that will allow food vans to operate on certain Council properties (e.g. from carparks at Council parks and reserves) as long as a range of health, safety, environment and amenity requirements are met.

Playspace Strategy - Planning for Play 2041

Glenorchy City Council currently has 44 playspaces, however our current play infrastructure is ageing with many requiring renewals and/or replacement.

Planning for Play 2041 - Playspace Strategy (the Strategy) is a strategy for the development of innovative, quality play opportunities in Glenorchy.

At its December meeting Council endorsed the Playspace Strategy - Planning For Play 2041 and officers have hit the ground running to start an internal audit on priority replacements pending annual budget allocation! Watch this space!

Active Glenorchy - Sport and Recreation Framework 2040

Council recognises the important role sport and recreation plays in making lives better by providing the opportunities to be active that our community values.

In March 2021, Council set about developing a long-term vision and framework for providing and managing its sport and recreation facilities and spaces.

Council has developed a Sport and Recreation Framework to guide the provision of sport, recreation, and facility development to 2040.

At its December meeting Council endorsed the Sport and Recreation Framework 2040 - Active Glenorchy.
