QUICK FACTS

178 people filled in the survey between 1-30 Nov 2023.

WHO DID WE REACH?

- 25.9% were 19 years old or younger
- 12% are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- 13.5% identify as LGBTIQ+
- 44.9% are currently parenting
- 6.7% are foster carers, 5% are kinship carers
- 62.4% female, 32.6% male, 2.2% nonbinary
- 1.7% other gender identity
- 1.1% no gender stated
